


Application deadline 25 February

SELECTION CRITERIA

Application submitted online by the deadline 25 February

Criteria:

- 1) average grade 7 and higher (60%), no academic debt
- 2) motivation statement (20%): why exchange studies, choice of university, etc
- 3) recent, in the past 6 months, extra-curricular activity (20%): SA, Buddy for Erasmus students, representing RGSL at public events, student conferences, Moots, promotional campaigns

Reference letter — can be a signed letter or brief e-mail statement from the reference provider directly to Erasmus coordinator (ulla@rgsl.edu.lv)

- > No financial debt, nor academic debt (research papers, exams, re-exams)
- ➤ No disciplinary sanctions in the past 6 months
- > Priority students applying for the first time

What happens after RGSL application?

- ✓ Decision by Selection committee sent by email individually to student within 3 weeks
- ✓ Student replies and confirms the interest has not changed
- ✓ RGSL Erasmus coordinator submits student **nomination** to partner university
- ✓ Partner university will contact the student directly check your SPAM mail, student must follow their application deadlines and submit required documents.
- ✓ READ all website links and brochures carefully and in detail provided by the receiving university for «incoming exchange students»
- ✓ Online Learning Agreement will have to be prepared (usually towards the end of registration with partner university, but certainly before the travel departure)
- ✓ Choice of study subjects must be pre-approved by Bachelor programme director via email with proposed subjects, ECTS and links to course outlines
- ✓ Financial grant agreement signed ~1 month prior departure, advance payments transferred 90% of the total semester grant

Practicalities-how to prepare before departure?

- 1. Passport or e-ID valid for the entire exchange semester and longer
- 2. Students EU citizens must have European Health Insurance Card (EVAK)
- 3. 'Drošs elektroniskais paraksts' = e-paraksts for smooth digital signing of student-RGSL financial grant agreements. For Latvian students mandatory, but strongly recommended for everyone

Personal financial resources - Erasmus grant <u>will not cover</u> all expenses (books, travel, expensive housing)

Accommodation, accommodation, accommodation !!!!

Seek suggestions from RGSL students previously studied in this city
